Letter From Our President

2023 marked Year No. 2 of a multiyear journey to prepare Heritage Fund to mark its 50th anniversary in 2026. Heritage Fund board members began planning for the half-century event back in 2022 by undertaking a strategic planning process capable of carrying the organization into the next 50 years and beyond.

The work of 2023 was charting the course — figuring out how to combine all the lessons learned since 1976 with today's growing resources and assets — so that Heritage Fund can make an even bigger and better difference in its second 50 years.

The Heritage Fund board recognized that a more focused approach to deploying resources would result in greater opportunities for change and/or improvements in each of our Impact Areas of:

- ➔ Downtown Vitality
- ➔ Arts, Culture, and Architecture
- ➔ Youth Development

Newly formed Impact Area committees gathered board members and community advisors and challenged them to create a shared understanding of barriers and opportunities, develop relationships among key stakeholders and begin to set priorities for funding and resources.

One lesson we quickly learned was to never assume that because we are a smaller community people know each other. Many of the early meetings were more about getting to know new people, learning about the organizations they represented and reaffirming that greater progress could be made if we joined forces and worked together.

On a related note, one plank of the Heritage Fund mission statement is to gather and grow community leaders. We were honored to host two leadership convenings in 2023. The idea was simply to bring together as many community leaders as we could identify, create an atmosphere where they could gather and encourage them to get to know one another.

Bartholomew County is among a handful of Indiana counties growing both in population size and population diversity. That is a strength to be envied but also a challenge. Maintaining the benefit of being a smaller community as we grow in size and complexity necessitates the need to be deliberate about fostering relationships among people. It is so much easier to fix a problem or make something good happen if you can reach out to the right people and know that they will work with you.

The Heritage Fund board and staff are honored to be part of a dedicated network of community leadership organizations. Knowing our mission to inspire generosity; gather and grow community leaders; and act with impact is critical to helping Bartholomew County be a place that people and families want to live, work, learn and play.

We also know that our donors who have so generously shared resources make this work possible. Each new gift or the establishment of a new fund, be it a scholarship, a donor advised fund or a personal foundation, is a cause for celebration.

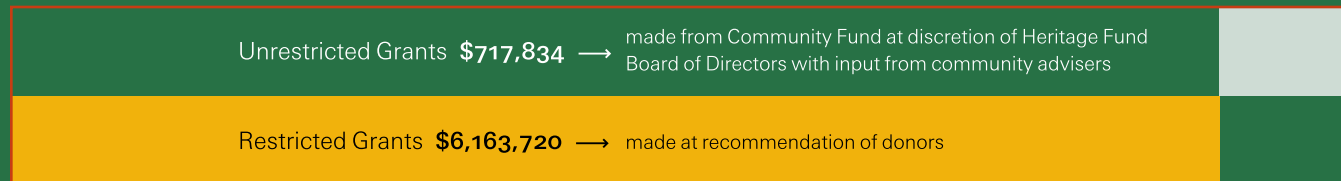

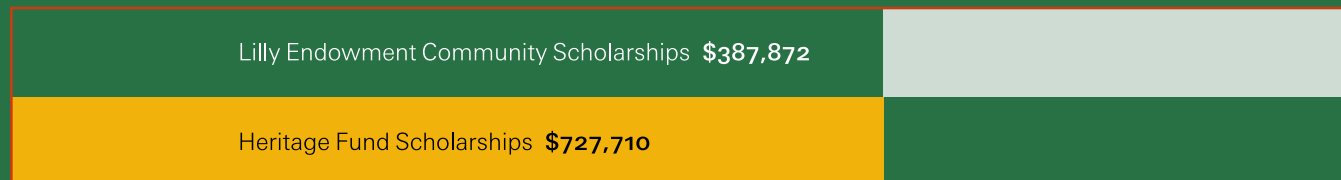

Downtown Vitality

PURPOSE

Heritage Fund seeks to develop our community's current assets to help make our downtown a *vibrant and thriving* place for all community members.

»»» **WHO**

»»» **WHY**

Downtowns are described as the living rooms of communities. Our living room has experienced significant changes in the past five years. Work, life and the balance between look different today and require creative development and activation of our current assets. As we look toward the future of our downtown, we are searching for how it can grow to meet the evolving needs of our community.

»»» **HOW**

Heritage Fund will continue to explore how our existing assets can be further developed in the downtown area to support future growth.

AREAS OF IMPACT

In 2023, Heritage Fund staff and board, along with community advisers and stakeholders, dedicated themselves to creating strategies and funding priorities to make advancements in our Impact Areas of Downtown Vitality, Youth Development and Arts, Culture, and Architecture.

Downtown Vitality

The Office of Downtown Development opened its doors to foster a *revitalized city center* in 2023. A \$75,000 Heritage Fund grant supported the ODD organization as a collaborative effort with Cummins Inc., SIHO, Johnson Ventures, city of Columbus and private funders. ODD currently is focused on retention and development to ensure the success of current businesses and making the downtown *an attractive home* for new ones. Executive Director Ike DeClue said dedicated offices like ODD are becoming increasingly common and that the downtowns in the state that are most successful have one, if not multiple, organizations focused on the city centers. He looks to Columbus' downtown to become the *place people choose to go* — whether it be for a date or family night or to both live and work. Successes for the organization in 2023 were city grant funding for building improvements, a text sign-up for information on downtown events and new restaurants on board to open in 2024.

CATCHING WITH EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR IKE DeCLUE



How would you describe our downtown currently?

Downtown is in transition. Post COVID, many downtowns are having to reinvent themselves. They can no longer rely on the volume of office workers they once had. We could look at this as an obstacle, or we can look at this as an opportunity to determine what downtown looks like moving forward.

Why is a Heritage Fund focus on Downtown Vitality important?

Downtowns are the heart of any city. Much of our history resides in our downtowns. A vibrant downtown is at the center of any prosperous city.

Future plans?

Looking forward we will continue to work with new and existing businesses to make downtown an even more exciting place than it is today. We are also working on bringing a few more free music events downtown over the warm months. With the additional housing, we also have a higher density of people living downtown. This in itself will provide some exciting opportunities, and we look forward to doing our part to make downtown a place for everyone to live, work and play!

Youth Development

PURPOSE

Heritage Fund seeks to improve the quality of life for *all children* in Bartholomew County by leveraging our resources and working with partners to achieve positive outcomes in the following focus areas:

Youth Mental Health

Social Emotional Learning

Early Learning

→ WHO

The Youth Development Committee is comprised of board members with input from local experts in the field. Committee members: Kathy Oren, Dr. Jim Roberts, Mark Stewart, Katie Glick, Phil Luzius

→ WHAT

Committee members met to review data and learn from local experts to answer the question: "How does Heritage Fund contribute to ensuring all children in Bartholomew County have the best quality of life?"

→ WHY

There is a lot of good work happening in Bartholomew County to benefit youth. Heritage Fund wants to leverage our investment in Youth Development with other partners across the community to ensure that we can have the greatest impact on the lives of local children.

→ HOW

Heritage Fund will focus our Youth Development grantmaking in two priority areas: 1. Youth Mental Health / Social Emotional Learning (including parent / family engagement) and 2. Early Learning (with a focus on literacy and 0–3 child care). We will monitor progress by looking at community data including: youth mental health indicators from the Search Institute Survey and Indiana Youth Institute; IREAD third-grade reading scores; and child-care indicators (available slots; number of high-quality programs; affordability).



GROWING READERS

Youth Development

The Growing Readers program is hoping *to nurture a love of reading* at a young age. An \$11,500 grant from Heritage Fund supported the two-year pilot program, which is a partnership between Bartholomew County Public Library, Viewpoint Books and local pediatric and family medicine offices that encourages children to *hear/read 1,000 books* before kindergarten. Books are distributed to children during preventative care visits with their doctor between ages 0 and 5. This novel approach provides a well-attended and perfect opportunity to get high-quality and age-appropriate *books in little hands*. Viewpoint curates and delivers books and literacy education packages to the offices, and BCPL assists with programming. In addition to books, Growing Readers covers another aspect of early literacy by providing caregiver education to families. A program like this is crucial, organizers say, because of the *proven benefits* of early exposure to books and reading at a young age, as well as the importance of *providing education to empower families* to take part in their children's literacy development. More than 1,800 books were distributed during the first seven months of the program, and organizers are looking to increase the number of medical offices involved and establish long-term funding to continue the program in the future.

The reception from families has been amazing. Children's eyes light up when they are told they get to take their books home. Some parents instantly engage with their children, and we get to reinforce this and comment about the importance of reading.

Arts, Culture, & Architecture

PURPOSE

Heritage Fund seeks to *enhance our community's experience* with and connection to arts, culture, and architecture.

➤ WHO

➤ WHY

The arts are a direct line to an enhanced quality of life and are a desirable feature in any community. Bartholomew County has a storied history of supporting the arts and is lucky to now hold many assets of arts, culture, and architecture. We see it as a responsibility to not only maintain but grow these assets to celebrate who we have been and who we strive to be as a community.

➤ HOW

Heritage Fund will support the work of our strong arts and culture organizations to amplify their collective work and find new opportunities for programming, collaborations and broad community initiatives.

Arts, Culture, & Architecture

Through the Empowering and Connecting Creatives project, the Columbus Area Arts Council provides a series of *artist-led workshops* and *open studio sessions* to create opportunities for artists and other creatives to learn or sharpen skills, build *local art relationships* to expand creative networks and work independently under the guidance of *experienced mentors*. The pilot series includes local artist-led workshops in four disciplines (clay, glass, screen printing, and welding) followed by weekly open-studio hours for participants to practice. This project, supported by an \$11,000 Heritage Fund grant, aligns with the vision of our Arts, Culture, and Architecture Committee. In addition, it activates Propeller, a new makerspace located at the Columbus AirPark.

Why is a program like this important?

Our current arts community lacks cohesion and connectivity. This program seeks to unite local creatives in a space dedicated to skill development. By fostering relationships among creatives, we cultivate shared learning, collaboration, and a deeper connection to our community.

How does Heritage Fund grant support help?

This program owes its existence to the generous financial support of Heritage Fund. Furthermore, the insightful questions posed by the Grants Committee during the application review prompted me to re-evaluate program details and establish a system for measuring success, a practice we now implement across all our artist engagement initiatives.

What were program highlights/successes for 2023?

The program's highlight is its robust partnership with Taglia Tool, a locally owned business specializing in fabricating tools for glass art. Our shared vision aims to position Columbus as a premier destination for glass artwork. Leveraging the Arts Council's artist-led workshops and open studio sessions, we serve as feeder programs for Taglia Tool's advanced glass studio and program, further enhancing our collaborative efforts.

Future plans for the program?

Moving forward, we are committed to sustaining and expanding our efforts, seeking further funding through private donations and community backing. Our focus remains on nurturing the clay and glass studios to actively involve local artists and foster a thriving creative community.





Community Leadership Convenings

As part of our pledge to gather and grow community leaders, Heritage Fund hosted a set of Leadership Convenings in 2023. The springtime event at Ivy Tech’s Moravec Hall saw dozens of both longtime and up-and-coming leaders connect and help us begin discussion on our Areas of Impact. We followed up in October with a spirited carnival-themed courtyard event that gave some 80 community leaders a chance to gather, network and have a little fall fun.



The HFBC Leadership Convenings have provided a valuable opportunity for individuals in our community to network, exchange ideas, and gain insights from one another. It’s been terrific to see existing and emerging leaders come together to discuss ways to make a positive impact on the community.

Community Fund Grants

Su Casa – Taylorsville Expansion

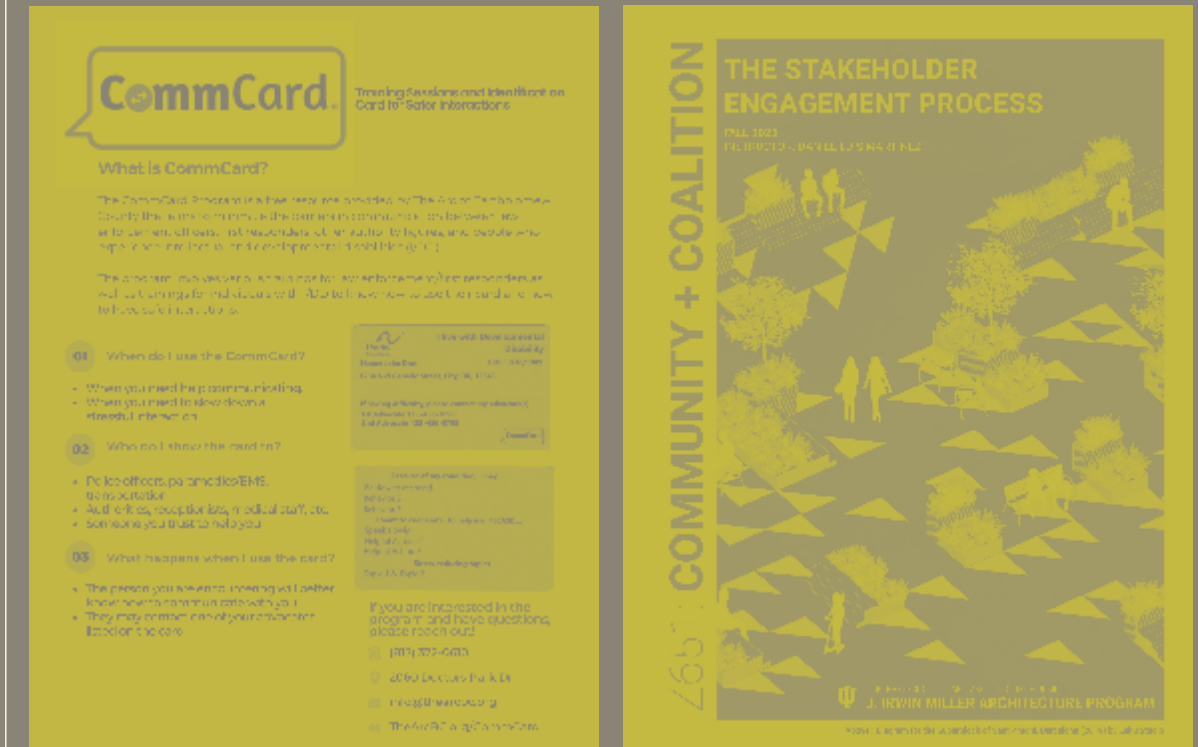
Su Casa launched a Taylorsville program to meet the increasing needs of the Latino population in the area. La Morena restaurant provided a temporary office for Su Casa to provide services to neighborhood residents. A Family Support Specialist was hired from the Heritage Heights neighborhood to provide services to residents of the Taylorsville area including housing services, Love Chapel food pantry assistance, referrals to partner United Way agencies, documentation and legal support, employment application assistance, Medicaid and SNAP applications, registration for outside programming and more. The first \$31,011 installment of a multiyear Heritage Fund grant supported this work.

The Arc of Bartholomew County – CommCard Program

The Arc of Bartholomew County launched the CommCard Program to help break down communication barriers between helping professionals, first responders, community service providers and people who experience communication difficulties or other disabilities. The program, supported by a \$15,000 Heritage Fund grant, includes a fully customizable card carried by a person who needs accommodation. The card includes the name of the cardholder, the names and contact information of two advocates, behaviors that may be misunderstood and suggestions for communication accommodations. The CommCard program aims to serve the majority of the roughly 26 percent of individuals in our community who have a disability.

IU School of Architecture

As part of the IU School of Architecture Master's program, third-year students complete a course in which they practice broad community engagement and coalition building. In 2023, Heritage Fund partnered with IU to provide \$3,000 in funding to develop student projects in the Community and Coalition Building class. Student groups developed their concepts by engaging with community stakeholders in downtown Columbus throughout their academic term. IU students explored further activation of the 6th Street Arts Alley, thoughtful development of more options for food and beverage in the downtown, and a piloted mural program. Students hosted their final, interactive presentations with community stakeholders late in the year.

- ➔ Sri Ganesh Mandir Hindu Temple celebrated its one-year anniversary. The Hindu community in Columbus has grown to more than 500 families who now have a permanent space for worship, education and community building.
- ➔ Columbus Chinese Association hosts a Chinese Language School Sunday afternoons at Columbus North High School.
- ➔ Bartholomew Consolidated School Corporation has offered Legado Spanish Immersion Academy for students from pre-K to sixth grade at Clifty Creek since 2018.
- ➔ The African American Foundation of Bartholomew County, managed by Heritage Fund, is celebrating its 10th anniversary with a fundraising campaign to continue its work to elevate Black lives through focusing on education, economic and leadership development, health awareness and arts and culture.
- ➔ Columbus, IN Pride has hosted its annual Pride Fest since 2018.
- ➔ The Irwin Financial Donor-Advised Fund at Heritage Fund has administered a scholarship program for DACA and undocumented students since 2013.
- ➔ 2023 marked the 13th year of the Women’s Giving Circle (WGC) at Heritage Fund. The WGC is a membership organization for women interested in giving back in Bartholomew County and supporting causes that improve lives for women and children. In 2023 we invested more than \$28,000 in projects and programs that supported our local early learning and child-care sector, helped women in crisis and provided leadership development and networking opportunities for local women.



The Women’s Giving Circle Speaker Series was launched to bring women in our community together to discuss important issues that impact us all – early learning, mental health and women in leadership. The series created a forum for learning, collaboration and activation, which we all need to do more of to create impact in our community.

S. Paul Hill Memorial Fund

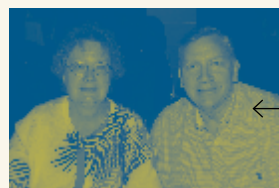
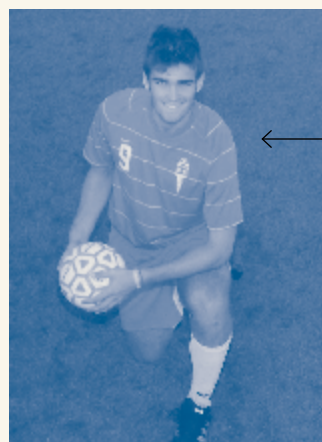
A Field of Interest Fund established in February 2023 by the family of Sylvester Paul Hill to celebrate his life. Paul was a 1959 graduate of Hauser High School who had an extensive career in the automotive business. In 2001, he opened Hill's Auto Sales and Service in Hope with two of his siblings. He loved helping people and was a mentor to many. Through a partnership with Bartholomew Consolidated School Corporation and the C4 program, this fund will benefit students by providing support for automotive education/automotive technology in Bartholomew County. Funds may be used to purchase tools, equipment, and/or curriculum to assist students in broadening their education related to automobile maintenance and/or automotive technology. Funds will also support student fees related to certifications, training, and/or competitions related to automotive education.

Kelly Family Fund for Journey North Professional Development

Established in August 2023 by the Kelly Family, represented by Terri Kelly. The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships to staff members of Journey North to support professional development opportunities.

Zach Deak Golden Boot Scholarship Fund

Scholarship established by family and friends in September 2023 to celebrate the life of Zach Deak. Zach played soccer for Columbus East from 2007–11, setting a single season scoring record that lasted for a decade. He was All-Area, All-Conference and 1st Team All-State and went on to play at the collegiate D2 level. He was studying to be a dentist when he was in a fatal car accident July 2023. The scholarship will be awarded for postsecondary education to graduating seniors from Columbus East High School who played varsity soccer during their high school career and exemplified a true passion for soccer, hard work and competitiveness. Special consideration will be given to players who plan to play soccer in college and/or are pursuing a dentistry degree.
